6. Old or Unfinished Business
 - 6.1. Before & After School Care RFP
S.Strasser shared that the district will be issuing a Request for Proposals (RFP) to explore options for contracting out Before & After School Care. This is exploratory and based on continued staffing shortages, education and experience levels of current staffing to safely meet the needs of our students, and to provide consideration of vendors that can facilitate the Wisconsin Shares program to support qualifying families.
7. New Business
 - 7.1. Facility Projects
An update was provided on the various projects under consideration. These include a vision for best utilization of the current girls locker room at the AFC, a warm water and lap walking pool at the AFC as part of Phase 3 construction, and upgrades to the outdoor community athletic and open spaces at Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate School.
 - 7.2. High School Sports Satisfaction Survey
The district is working with School Perceptions to administer the End of Year High School Athletic Satisfaction Survey to student athletes and parents. The survey is tentatively scheduled to go out late April and conclude data collection by the end of May. This is the second year of the survey and will provide valuable data in comparison to our year one baseline data. We hope to demonstrate growth based on implemented initiatives from the 2024-2025 school year feedback.
