## **ACTION ITEM**

## Perkins Act Fiscal Requirements

(NEW Policy – First Reading)

Upon direction from Clark Hill, we have received a new section of board policy pertaining to Perkins grant funds and the fiscal requirement of supplement, not supplant.

Earlier this year, the Michigan Department of Education's Office of Career and Technical Education issued a memorandum stating that it will require every region to establish and adopt a policy regarding the supplement, not supplant requirement under Perkins. Pursuant to the memorandum, board policies must be adopted by August 1, 2025.

Therefore, we are presenting to the Board the recommendation of adding *Article VI - Finances, Section 21- Perkins Act Fiscal Requirements* to our current board policy to be in compliance with MDE's requirements.

## RECOMMENDATION

Move to approve the First Reading of new board policy **Perkins Act Fiscal Requirements** to be placed under *Article VI – Finances, Section 21* of the current Ionia County ISD Board Policies.
