OVERVIEW

During the 2023-24 school year, the middle school team worked to align key structures across Brooks and Julian to ensure baseline consistency in instructional systems.

As we begin our process of alignment, one key initiative has been bringing more consistency to our master schedule across middle schools.

We will continue this important work during the 2024-25 school year.

BACKGROUND

Before COVID-19, District 97 middle schools had all nine periods, but during the pandemic the middle schools pivoted to block scheduling.

During the 2023-24 school year, we began re-examine the middle school master schedule to **ensure alignment** between schools

Next year we will be working to **rebuild the master schedule** to meet our vision for the future of District 97 middle schools.


 Parallel course names/bell schedules will allow us to redesign for the universal design of rigorous, culturally and linguistically learning experiences and students outcomes

As the middle school team focused on learning and aligning our systems, we found that Brooks and Julian Middle Schools currently has:

- Different bell schedules and course names
- Inconsistencies in some course offerings







2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR (NOW)

During the 2023-24 school year, the middle school leadership team worked to achieve greater consistency in our master schedule by:

- Conducting an internal audit of the IB program
- Aligned course names to ISBE course names for the 2024-25 school year
- Eliminating C/J days, beginning at the start the 2024-25 school year
