ACADEMIC OVERVIEW:

The SHS Ag Mechanic students transformed their wood and metal shop into a food packing lab. With partnership to Food For All, the agriculture science students proceeded to package produce to family size portions. They received about 40,000 pounds of various produced including potatoes, onions, apples, parsnips, rutabagas, beets, turnips, carrots, pears, mixed veggie bags, celery, oranges, and dried fruit.

They were able to package that food for over 1,200 families throughout Northwest Oregon. They also partnered with the Grandsherimina Food Bank and added produce to Christmas boxes for families in the Sheridan area. The whole package of food, received by 125 families, included everything they should have needed for a Christmas dinner, including turkey.

Senior Projects are continuing and will culminate in presentations starting the month of April. One senior project scheduled to take place soon is a Red Cross Blood Drive on January 26, 2017. It will take place in the old gym from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm.

Sheridan High School would like to restart the National Honor Society at our school. The plan is to get it going for the second semester this school year.

We were fortunate to have students who were chosen to "Shop with a Cop" during the Winter Break. Students were given \$50 to buy for themselves, \$50 to buy for a family member and they also had the opportunity to have lunch with a police officer.

The Drama class will present their play, "Lagooned," on Sunday, January 22, 2017 during two performances, one at 2:00 pm and the second at 6:00 pm. We would like to invite you to attend.
