



Temporary Naming of Timberland Property

Situation

The new middle school in the Timberland neighborhood will serve as a temporary school for four schools (Vose, William Walker, Hazeldale, and ACMA) as their existing schools are rebuilt over the next several years. Each school will rotate for one year through the school while the new schools are built on their existing sites. We have established a temporary naming convention for these schools.

Background

Naming the schools rotating through the new middle school site

The school name would shift each year, as each rotates through the site, combining the existing school name and location of the new middle school (118th & Stone Mountain Road).

The four temporary school names would be:

- Vose Elementary at 118th (2016-2017)
- William Walker Elementary at 118th (2017-2018)
- Hazeldale Elementary at 118th (2018-2019)
- Arts & Communication Magnet Academy at 118th (2019-2020)

This naming convention is being used for the following reasons:

- To lessen confusion between the existing school site and the temporary school site.
- Calling out the temporary location in the name reinforces that the school is in transition and on site temporarily.
- Timberland has been used to reference the new middle school site during construction, however, there will be a formal naming process involving the school community and the School Board.

The process of formally naming the new middle school will occur when the middle school's community and attendance area can be confirmed and prior to the school opening as a middle school in the 2020-2021 school year.
