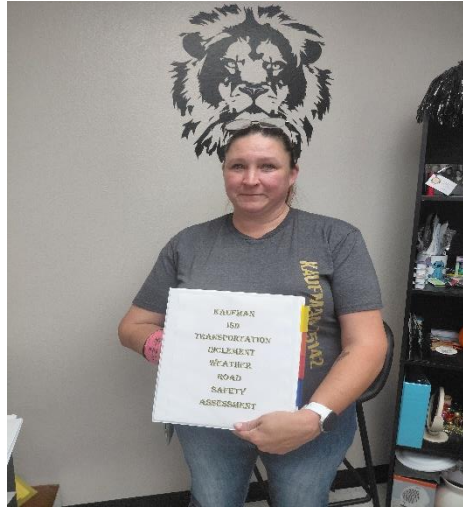
A New Lion
