The Wylie UIL Social Studies team was recently crowned the Best of Texas Champion! The Best of Texas Contest determines a winner by combining the team scores from across three rounds of competition. Not only was Wylie the 5A State Champion, they were also the Overall State Champion! WOver 50 teams and 250 individuals competed in this year's Best of Texas Contest.

### UIL Spelling

The UIL Spelling & Vocabulary team had a strong performance at the Region 1 contest in Lubbock last weekend. Junior Tehzeeb Grewal qualified for state with her 1st place finish at regionals, and she will be competing on May 14 for the state title.

### UIL Regional Runner-Up

The Wylie UIL Academics team competed at the Region 1-5A Academic Meet at Texas Tech this past weekend. Wylie was crowned the Region Runner-up Sweepstakes Champion! Thirteen Wylie students qualified individually or as part of a team for the State Academic Meet at UT Austin in May.

### Wylie Tennis to State

Wylie's two mixed doubles teams winning first and second in District. Trevor Short and Hope Willis won the gold. Their teammates, Brandon Cowling and Kate Delgado won the silver. This past week at the Regional tournament both pairs claimed their ticket to state.

### TMSCA at State

TMSCA State (Texas Math and Science Coaches Association), held in San Antonio. Twenty-four 5A teams competed. Wylie was 10th overall.

The Bulldogs Golf team earned the District 4-5A title this past golf season. The Lady Bulldogs were the district runner up. The Bulldogs ended their season as 5th in the Region.

### **Texas Citizen Bee**

On March 26th and 28th, Wylie High School students participated in the Region 14 Texas Citizen Bee. This competition is made up of a multiple choice test and an oral competition. Canyon South placed 2nd and Anthony Tovar placed 1st. Anthony Tovar competed at the state meet and placed 5th in the state!

### **One Act Play at Regionals**

Wylie High Theater competed at the regional level in the One Act Play Competition and finished 4th in the region. The 4th place finished ranked Wylie OAP in the top 16 in the state.

### **UIL Academics**

The Wylie UIL Academics team were crowned District Champion at the District 4-5A Academic Meet with several teams winning their prospective events.

### **State VASE Art**

Wylie High took 14 works to State VASE this past weekend. Stats are as follows: 33,000 works from across the state were entered into VASE. Of those, ONLY 2,300 were chosen to go to State VASE and we have 14 of those. At State Vase this past weekend in San Marcos, we got a chance to see all 2,300 amazing works of art and came home with 4 STATE MEDALS!

### **Lady Bulldog and Bulldog Track & Field**

The Lady Bulldogs had 7 competitors and the Bulldogs had 5 competitors earn their way out of Area to the Regional track meet. All athletes represented Wylie High School well, and many PR.

### **FFA to State**
