Special Education:

Their teamwork has been amazing and allows us to remain compliant as we cover services for the remainder of the year.
- The paraprofessional PD day is completely virtual and offers a wide range of topics from <u>Michigan Virtual</u> and <u>The Iris Center</u>. By having this day be all virtual, it removes the barrier of childcare and also addresses the individual requests for certain topics.

Early Childhood:
