 - We reviewed the most recent **DIBELS scores** indicating significant growth in reading since the beginning of the year.
 - We discussed the idea of "bullying", and need a more precise definition to present to students and staff. Targeting? Intimidation? Rudeness? Meanness? Alicia would like to develop a possible trifold document explaining exactly what bullying looks like, and how to best advocate for and prevent victims.
 - With widespread representation from our school community at this meeting, we
 discussed the value of homework for K-5 students. Alicia will develop a short
 questionnaire for families, to gauge parents' feelings about the value of homework at this
 academic level. We will discuss results next month. Questions might include:
 - a. I feel like the amount of homework is appropriate for my child's grade level.
 - b. I feel like homework is beneficial to my student's education.
