PROGRAM GOAL:

Drop Out Prevention

The PASS program, currently implemented at all four UISD high schools, aims to improve attendance and reduce the dropout rate. This program targets current “out-of-cohort” students at risk of not graduating with their class due to credit loss from excessive absences or extenuating circumstances.
