AN ORDINANCE OF THE ALEDO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL
DISTRICT ADOPTING THE 2010 – 2011 SCHOOL PROPERTY
TAX.

WHEREAS, the Aledo Independent School District located in Parker County, Texas;

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted a public hearing on this matter;

WHEREAS, I, _____, move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$1.4252, a zero percent increase in the tax rate, seconded by _____. This total equates to \$1.17 for Maintenance & Operations (M & O), which is effectively a 12.5% percent increase in the tax rate and \$0.2552 (a reduction) for current year Debt Service (I & S).
