District 33 currently has one School Resource Officer (SRO.) The current SRO spends the majority of his time supporting the needs of students, staff, and administrators at the middle school. District administration is recommending a second School Resource Officer primarily for elementary school buildings. This SRO would work a staggered schedule to allow for SRO presence at after school activities and sports.	
Background or historical information: (Considerations)	
A School Resource Officer is an effective method of fostering positive relationships with students in order to promote greater respect for law enforcement. A SRO will contribute to the educational environment by paticipating in preventative programs that focus on deterring youth involvement in criminal acts with a focus on reduced gang involvement and alcohol and drug use.
