- **Teacher Development & Evaluation (TD/E)** We will be working to revise the district's TD/E plan to meet MDE's updated requirements and yes, this means no more iObservation. The updated plan will be in place for the upcoming school year.
- Advisory We will be working on an advisory calendar in the next month. The plan includes aligning to the student broadcast, student meetings, grade checks, student reflections and other Greenway priorities. A draft will be shared with staff in the next update.
- **Room Moves & Schedules** We are continuing to solidify class schedules and coordinate room moves. If this impacts you, you'll hear directly from us soon. Thanks for your patience and flexibility!
- **Handbook Updates** We're reviewing and updating the student/teacher handbooks to reflect current expectations and policies.
- **Portrait of a Graduate** This will continue to guide our school-wide priorities. Professional development and inservice plans will incorporate Power Standards and embedding Portrait of a Graduate traits into our curriculum and instruction.
- **MTSS Work** Katie Heimdal is leading our district-wide MTSS alignment to ensure consistent practices across our schools. This work is foundational for student success and staff clarity.
- **Staffing & Interviews** We have two vacancies: 7-12 Math and 6-12 Band/Music. We are currently interviewing candidates for the math position and will look to interview music candidates the 2nd week in July. Our new teachers Mr. Potter & Mr. Witikko have been spotted on campus! If you happen to see them, please welcome them aboard! We will be highlighting our new staff on Facebook soon!
- Learning Academy started this week, and REACH last week! Thank you to all staff supporting these opportunities for students.
- **Summer Weight Training** We've had an amazing turnout — around 60 students are attending the morning sessions and 15 in the evenings! Big thanks to Carli Haynes, Will Floersheim, Nick Emanuel, Mark Motherway, Grant Troumbly and all the coaches supporting our athletes' growth and discipline this summer.
- Activities Collaborative Work Will Floersheim and Justin Sundquist have been working on better balancing activities administration responsibilities between Greenway and Nashwauk-Keewatin. In addition, initial conversation/planning is underway to potentially combine the two remaining programs not combined between the districts, with boy's basketball possibly combined for the Winter 2025-26 season and initial exploration of combining volleyball for the Fall 2026 season.
