The Three Rivers School District School Board conducted Superintendent Valenzuela's annual performance review on April 21, 2021.

The Board is pleased with Superintendent Valenzuela's performance over the last year, especially with how he has led Three Rivers School District (TRSD) through the pandemic during the 2020-2021 school year. While the pandemic has been disruptive to the typical classroom environment, TRSD under the leadership of Superintendent Valenzuela, has maintained a focus on keeping students engaged and allowing in-person instruction to the extent allowed under the Ready Schools, Safe Learners guidance. TRSD has maintained a flexible approach through this time, anticipating changes in state guidance and responding quickly. The District's attention to successful virtual learning environments has benefitted students and will be a resource on into the future.

We look ahead with hope that our school settings will return to a more typical environment, but with hope that we can utilize lessons and tools gained during this difficult year for the ongoing betterment of our educational process.
