Date: November 13, 2024

HISTORY: Due to student enrollment at the campus and student restroom use increasing in hallway 200, the need to accommodate more students and not have them wait was identified. Therefore, the addition of an extra toilet on both the girls and the boys restrooms was requested.

RATIONALE: The rationale is to use the existing footprint of the restrooms and use the available space to accommodate an additional toilet for the boys and for the girls. The contractor will remove and dispose of existing lavatories, demolish existing wall where lavatories exist, demo wall tiles, demo sections of floor concrete to allow for new pipework. To install new Schedule 40 PVC pipe and PVC fittings for drains and vents, Copper Type 1 1", ¾", ½" and pro-press, install 2 regular toilets for flush valves, 2 flush valves, 2 retro fit kits for the flush valves, 2 wall mount lavatories with back splash and 1 waterless urinal. Installation of rough-in, top out, relocate 1 urinal and relocate 1 toilet. Scope of work also includes all repairs to walls, installation of tiles, paint walls, placement of concrete and tile flooring, and remove, paint and reinstall existing partition panels and doors. Remove & Re-install mirrors, hand soap dispenser, and toilet tissue dispenser.

BUDGET: The cost is \$\$62,948.63 (The funds to cover this work will be from the 199-account budget).

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION: The administrative recommendation is to approve the purchase order for AREDi Enterprises, LLC.
