

RESOLUTION 10-69 – Approval of Personnel Contracts

This resolution seeks Board approval to hire the individual in the position listed below:

Background: Due to a resignation, a vacancy exists for Speech & Language Pathologist, Related Services in the Department of Special Education Services. As a result of recruitment and screening, the following individual has been selected and is recommended to fill this vacancy. The background of the applicant being recommended to the Board for approval is as follows:
