November 10, 2020**

The special meeting of the Board of Education was held on November 10, 2020 and was live-streamed via YouTube. President Zurek called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

- Option 1 – Current Model
- Option 2 – Shortened Day with all specials and electives virtually
- Option 3 – A/B Schedule
- Option 4 – Hire additional staff
- Option 5 – Full Remote

The Board of Education will be making a decision at the next Board of Education meeting on November 17, 2020.
