INVESTIGATIONS CONDUCTED ON DISTRICT PREMISES

~~Any investigation of abuse of a child will be directed by the Oregon Department of Human Services or law enforcement officials as required by law. When an administrator is notified that the Department of Human Services or law enforcement would like to interview a student at school, the administrator must request that the investigating official provide the information on Form 148, *Student Contact Report*. Failure to meet one of the criteria may result in the administrator's refusal to allow the student interview on district property.~~

When an administrator is notified that law enforcement would like to interview a student at school for the purpose of an investigation that is not related to abuse of a child, the administrator must request that the investigating official provide the information on **this** Form 148-A, *Student Contact Report*. Failure to meet one of the criteria may result in the administrator's refusal to allow the student interview on district property.
