Re: Press Policy 2nd Reading – Issue 118 - 1st Reading

The following policies have been updated and presented for the Board's review. The Board reviews policies in two readings: the first to discuss them and make changes as necessary, and the second to finalize any changes and adopt new policies. This is the 1st reading of the draft policies.

The policies have been modified due to changes in the law, legal references, and a review to ensure they are current.

Each policy includes footnotes with backup information on all changes. The recommendation for each policy is listed below.
