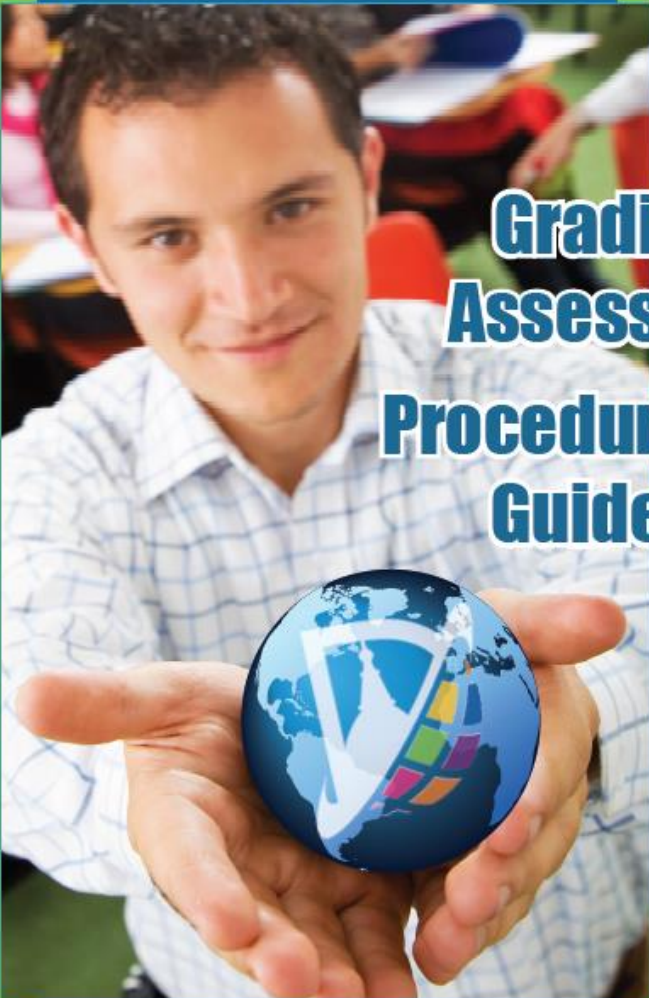

Because we believe errors are inherent in the learning process, all grades will be calculated using summative assessments only.

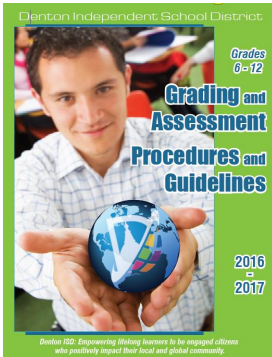
Section Five: Grading Practices

English Language Arts Writer's Workshop Appendix

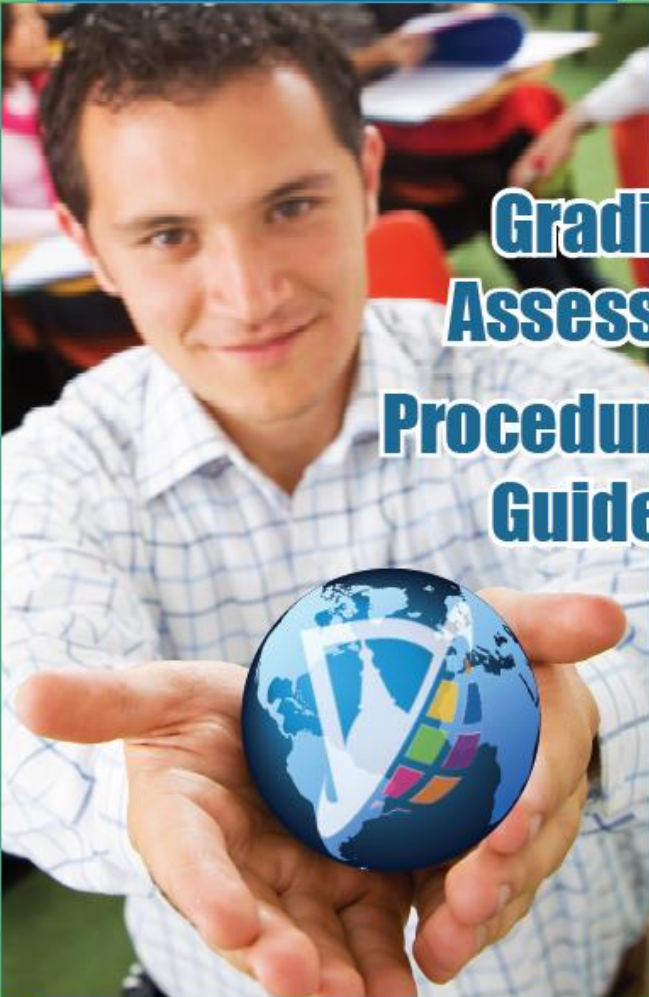
- Teachers have the *discretion to reassess papers* that are facilitated through the writer's workshop model
- Process Paper- a piece of writing that has evolved through the following stages: pre-writing, drafting, revising, editing and publication
- Writer's Workshop- Students participate in mini-lessons and receive feedback throughout the entire writing process
