Agenda Item Caption: Waiver Request for Students Taking Dual Credit Courses at Institutions of Higher Education with Calendars of Fewer than 75,600 Minutes for the 2024-2025, 2025-2026, and 2026-2027 School Years

Purpose of Agenda Item: Action needed

Administrative Recommendation: Move to approve the proposed waiver request for students taking dual credit courses at Temple College and Central Texas College with calendars of fewer than 75,600 minutes for the 2024-2025, 2025-2026, and 2026-2027 school years, as presented.

Background Information: The Texas Education Agency requires every Texas school district to adopt an attendance accounting system that includes procedures to ensure the accurate recording and reporting of student attendance data. According to the *Student Attendance Accounting Handbook*, to collect student attendance data, primarily to ensure that Foundation School Program (FSP) funds can be correctly allocated to Texas's public schools, students taking dual credit courses at Institutions of Higher Education (IHEs) with calendars of fewer than 75,600 minutes, may apply for a waiver of the 75,600 minute calendar requirement. This item was discussed at the June 18, 2024 Board Workshop.
