Re: First Quarter Financial Report

Revenues and Expenses should be at 25% of budgeted amounts.

Revenues

Revenue received is at 41%. It is trending high because the majority of tax dollars are received in the first quarter with early tax dollars received in the fourth quarter. Local funds are trending at 43.5%. State revenue is at 7.5%, trending low because the first quarter payments have not been received. Federal revenue is at 26%; Special Education funding is lagging at 0%, no state payments received this quarter. Property taxes collected is at 94.4% which includes early levy revenue from May and June. The last tax payment is released in October.

As of September 30th, the State had not made any payments except General State Aid. This is a shortfall in revenue of \$748,907.

Expenses

Expenses are at 15.3%, slightly less than the 25%.

In comparing FY 2015 and FY 2014 revenue and expenditures, revenues are level (41%-FY15 vs. 41.4% FY14) and expenditures are slightly higher (15.3%-FY15 vs. 13.9% FY14).
