

HS: The percentage of all students in Grade 11 at Mahtomedi High School who meet or exceed the district benchmark of 19 on the ACT Math and 18 on the ACT Reading strands will increase from 75% to 88% in Math and from 89% to 92% in Reading.

MS: The percentage of all students in grades 6,7, and 8 at MAHTOMEDI MIDDLE SCHOOL who meet or exceed their RIT Growth Score on the NWEA (MAP) ASSESSMENT in READING will increase from 68.5% in 2015 to 71.5% in 2016.

OHA: The proficiency gap between Students Not Identified as qualifying for Free and Reduced Price Lunch and Students Identified as qualifying for Free and Reduced Price Lunch by October 1 in grades 3 - 5 at O.H. Anderson Elementary School using all state reading accountability tests (MCA, MOD, MTAS) will decrease from a 9.9% in 2015 to 6.9% in 2016 increasing the proficiency rates of the groups as follows: Students not identified from 81.3% - 84.3%, Students identified from 71.4% - 77.4%.

WW: The percentage of all students in grades 1 and 2 at Wildwood Elementary who meet or exceed their fall to spring individual RIT Growth Projection on the NWEA MAP in Reading will increase from 70.3% in spring 2015 to 73.3% in spring 2016.
