**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This report gives an overview of the Summer School program for the 2016-2017 school year. Grades 5, 8, and 9-12 students served in Summer School are enrolled to receive accelerated instruction due to failure on state assessments. Pre-K/K ESL students are required to attend 120 hours of summer enrichment. Summer School also serves dyslexic students in grades 3-8. Credit Recovery students that did not complete their program in May were able to attend Summer School to finish.
