
- Our Goal:  **we are**  self-directed, lifelong learners  effective communicators  complex, creative & adaptive thinkers  collaborative & productive citizens

Post Secondary Plans: A Recent Snapshot



- As of June 30, 2019, **88%** of the Class of 2019 had plans to attend college or further their education.
- The additional 12% are:
 - Extending Education
 - Employed
 - Taking a 'Gap Year'
 - Still Making Plans
 - Other

Post- Secondary Plans

- Class of 2017
 - Formal Education- 85.3% (includes 4-year, 2-year and Vocational Programs)
 - Military- 2.7%
 - **Unknown- 12%**
- Class of 2018
 - Formal Education- 88.2% (includes 4-year, 2-year and Vocational Programs)
 - Military- 1.2%
 - **Unknown- 10.6%**
- Class of 2019
 - Formal Education- 86.4% (includes 4-year, 2-year and Vocational Programs)
 - Military- 1.1%
 - **Unknown- 12.5%**


