As has been past practice, the Board of Education approves, after review and recommendations from FAC (Facility Advisory Committee), capital projects to be undertaken. In October, 2010, the Board of Education approved the attached list of capital projects, including associated asbestos abatement work. Once approved by the Board, this work was given to the District's asbestos consulting firm, Environ International, Inc., to construct appropriate bid specifications and construction documents. Bids were let on February 3, 2011 with appropriate legal notice (included) appearing in the February 3, 2011 issue of the Oak Leaves. Such notice called for a mandatory pre-bid conference for 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 9, 2011, at which time 11 potential firms presented themselves (see attached list). A detailed letter from Environ International, Inc. is attached describing the process, along with a summary of the ten bids received.

The original budget for this asbestos abatement work was \$161,000 and the low bid submitted was provided by Valor Technologies in the amount of \$132,600 and, if the alternate is accepted (necessary abatement work associated with removal and installation of vinyl floor tile) in the amount of \$7,400, the grand total is \$140,400, or \$20,600 below budget. As indicated in the consultant's letter, "Valor has been in business for over ten years and Environ has managed several successful abatement projects that Valor has completed over the years."

It is the recommendation of Environ International, Inc., the Director of Buildings & Grounds and me that we award this asbestos abatement contract to Valor Technologies in the total amount of \$140,400. This will return to the Board for formal approval at its March 8, 2011 meeting.
