Curriculum & Instruction

The SAT will be offered October 1st and the PSAT will be held on October 12th. Juniors are encouraged to take the PSAT if they haven't taken a timed test like this before and to register for the SAT in the spring. Sophomores are also welcomed to take the PSAT.

The Fall MAP benchmark began Monday, September 19. Ninth and tenth grade students are tested in math, reading, and language. The benchmark results show us academic skills and concepts students have acquired, and what they are ready to learn. The test results are also used to group students for classroom intervention or enrichment according to skills or state standard.

Activities and Events

Cross-country runners have been practicing hard and had a good showing at their first meet, which was hosted here in Craig. Our top placers were Sam Bass at 4th place and Alexis Lawniki took 3rd. The team also travelled to Petersburg September 10, and will head to Ketchikan September 17. Their regional competition is slated to take place on October 1st in Sitka. State is October 9 in Anchorage. Currently, we have eight runners on the team.
