1. Mariana Delgado, third grader, received Second Place honors in the Peoples Telephone Valentine contest. A representative from Peoples Telephone attended an Elementary School assembly to present the monetary award of \$10.
2. Patsy Ramirez, Reading consultant, visited MES to assist in assessing our implementation of the Daily 5.
3. Anti-bullying and leadership groups are in full swing with our ETCADA program. Students have been working on finding common connections with others.
4. Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) have implemented interactive vocabulary and math walls in our hallways to reinforce STAAR vocabulary and problem solving.
5. LPAC (Language Proficiency Assessment Committee) met to make testing assessment accommodations for ELL students.
