On behalf of the PICOR Charitable Foundation, we appreciate the time and effort you invested to submit a 2017 funding application for our Foundation's "Ken Nickel Memorial Award" in recognition of programs assisting disadvantaged youth in the STEM fields. Keeling Elementary is a neighborhood school in the Amphitheater School District. We are located in a low socio-economic community with 98% of our students receiving free or reduced lunch. Our school provides an outstanding educational experience in a supportive, child-centered atmosphere. We are committed to our purpose of creating an inspired generation of learners who will, in turn, inspire the next. We strive to provide a foundation of experiences that students can draw on as they progress through their academic and career fields.

Our Program

The 4th grade state standards for social studies are focused on the State of Arizona. Part of the 3rd grade science standards includes a study of rocks and minerals. As a culmination of these studies, 4th grade teachers developed a field trip that provides the students with an experience that most would not have otherwise. The field trip is coordinated by Project Exploration. Project Exploration has been organizing educational field trips since 1977. Their services include transportation, an instructor, a night's stay in Flagstaff, entrance into the various destinations, and educational games and prizes. The students visit Montezuma's Castle, Meteor Crater, Wupatki National Monument, and a hike along Rim Trail at the Grand Canyon.

The cost of this trip is \$260 per student. The students do their own fundraisers with varying degrees of success, but in our demographic area, these students would not be able to participate in this trip if not for the generosity of individuals and companies. Many of these families are too proud to accept scholarships. Families would opt to keep kids home. The funds that we are awarded will be used to lower each child's cost in order to have higher participation.
