Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

At the February TRSD Board of Directors Meeting the Curriculum Department notified the board that it will be bringing forward a proposal for a K-5 adoption of Envision Math Program published by Pearson. We are requesting the board vote and approve this full K-5 adoption. The cost for grades 3-5 materials will be approximately 80,000 dollars and there will also be a need to spend another \$25,000 to replenish the K-2 program. In the future, starting in 2013-2014, there will be a need to annually spend approximately \$25,000 to replenish consumable materials for the K-2 portion of the program.

Provide history/background information on your proposal.

Due to the change in Oregon math standards in 2008 and now again with on transition to new Common Core Math Standards, K-5 teachers have been challenged with the inability use updated materials. Teachers and students have responded positively to the K-2 materials and 3-5 support the adoption of Envision Math.
