The Buckner Children & Family Services Inc. – FAYS (Family and Youth Success) Program provides services to youth 0-17 ages and their families in at-risk situations. The FAYS Program is designed to reduce family conflict, help with family support and skills and prevent the problems of runaway, school attendance issues and delinquent behaviors. The services for youth and families include screening/intake, crisis intervention, skills-based training presentations, case management, case follow-up and outreach through home visits, office visits and school and community visits. Youth and families will learn skills to help them resolve crisis among peers and family, develop their skills to cope with everyday problems and stresses in their lives and learn self-esteem concepts while developing communication skills and peer pressure refusal skills.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FY 2025/2026

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by **Buckner Children and Family Services, Inc. (Buckner)** through its Family and Youth Success program (Buckner FAYS Program) and **Brownsville Independent School District (BISD)**, for the sole purpose of providing FAYS Program services. All services will be provided free of charge to youth and families.

Buckner FAYS Program provides services to youth, 0 to 17 years of age, and their families in at-risk situations. Buckner FAYS Program is designed to reduce family conflict, help with family support and skills, and prevent the problems of runaway, school attendance issues and delinquent behaviors. Buckner FAYS Program helps youth and families resolve crises and establish and achieve goals that strengthen and promote healthy families. The services provided to the youth and families include screening/intake, crisis intervention, skills-based training, case management services, case follow-up and outreach. All services are free of charge to Brownsville ISD and the surrounding areas, and provided through home visits, office visits, and school and community visits.

Buckner FAYS Program will provide skills-based training weekly, or as scheduled, to qualifying students and their families. These curriculums may be conducted in a group setting and/or after school and will be delivered and tailored to the needs of the school. Youth and their families will learn skills to help them resolve crises among peers and family, develop their skills to cope with everyday problems and stresses in their lives, and learn self-esteem concepts while developing communications skills and peer pressure refusal skills.

General Responsibility of Buckner FAYS Program:

- Upon the receipt of referral, provide Intake process (which includes meeting with the youth's parents to obtain consent forms),
- Provide staff to conduct group skills training and counseling services,
- Provide program curriculum and supplies.

General responsibilities of Brownsville ISD:

- Provide student referrals,
- Provide class/school time for FAYS services,
- Provide class/facility space for groups and/or counseling services.
- Provide the use of equipment (TV and DVD) for group skills training.

This MOU will be in effect from September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2026.

Upon agreement by BISD, this cooperative working agreement shall be for one year and will be renewed annually. This MOU may be amended or modified in writing by either party, or terminated by either party, in writing with at least 30 days' notice before the termination.

Buckner staff providing services under this MOU shall submit to BISD all screening processes before providing services and BISD shall provide each staff a release form letter to complete visits to this school.
