Notes Regarding RFP# 06-32

Notes on current contract:

- 1. Current rates are \$145.18/day for 4-hour routes and \$16.39 for the excess hourly rate.
- 2. We are running 16 special ed routes. 14 of the 16 routes typically run over the allotted 4 hours per route by a total of about 10 1/2 hours per day.
- 2. We are running usually 38 regular routes. An average of about 20 routes exceed the 4 hours per route by an average of about 10 hours per day.
- 3. Bid document asked for 180 bus days per year. For 2006-07 we will have 175 student days for the regular school year.
- 4. Mid-day and late runs average about 100 hours per month and are billed at the excess rate of \$16.39.

Notes on 06-07 proposals:

REVISED INFORMATION BASED ON NEGOTIATIONS WITH DURHAM***

- ***1. The home-to school proposals have all used the same assumptions. The negotiated rate by Durham represents the lowest proposal. It is \$ 3.99 lower than Laidlaw and \$ 6.31 lower than STA.
- ***2. Each company has used a little different assumption to propose totals for the cost of excess hours and for late and mid-day runs, so the dollar totals cannot be compared directly. All companies used the same rate for mid-day and late runs as they did for excess hours, so the rate is the best comparison. The negotiated rate by Durham is \$ 0.53 lower than Laidlaw and \$ 1.00 lower than STA
- 3. Comparing STA's new proposal to the current rates, they have proposed a lower route rate (\$139.88 vs \$145.18) and the same excess hours rate (\$16.39).
- 4. For extracurricular transportation, STA proposed a lower rate than their excess hours rate (\$16.00). The other companies used their same rate as for excess hours. However, STA's rate was still higher than the other companies' rates.
- 5. No company proposed on a mileage cost rate.
