Per statute, the Board must have a public hearing to formally adopt an E-Learning Plan. The E-Learning Plan is adopted on a multi-year cycle and designed for use in specific emergency scenarios when regularly scheduled learning cannot be held (i.e., 'snow days'). The notice of the public hearing and public inspection was posted in the Kane County Chronicle on February 1, 2024.
