Classroom Technology

- The laptop carts at Minico High School in the English building have been totally refurbished. We have swept every room at Minico and found cables plugged in wrong, switches that shouldn't have been installed, and damaged cabling. It also was identified that we need to correctly wire some labs that were put together by adding switches to the room instead of wiring to the wiring closet. It was done wrong in the beginning because of the need of labs and the lack of funds. We also have identified that we need to run some more fiber to separate the network more efficiently. We have just under 2500 devices on the WiFi at Minico High School daily.
- We also have just setup 258 new laptops. Three carts of laptops went to East Minico, three carts went to West Minico, one cart to Rupert Elementary, and 1 cart to Minico High School.
