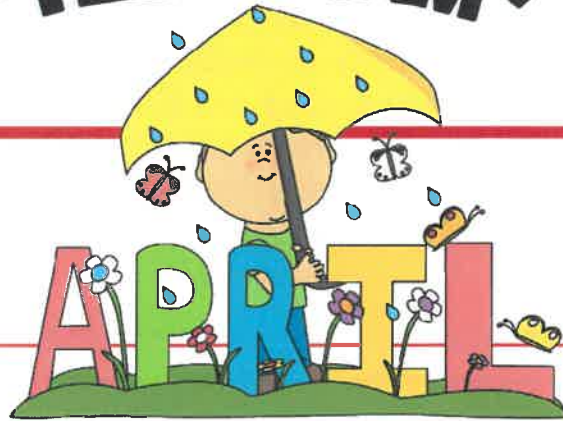

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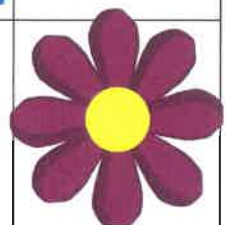

Back in the garden again!! Our new Garden Coordinator, Sarah DeVore had our students preparing the soil, as well as planting peas, kale, and spinach. In class we are starting lima beans to discuss the parts of a plant and watch the stages of growth.

K/1 Classroom

THIS COULD BE A FAMILY PROJECT.

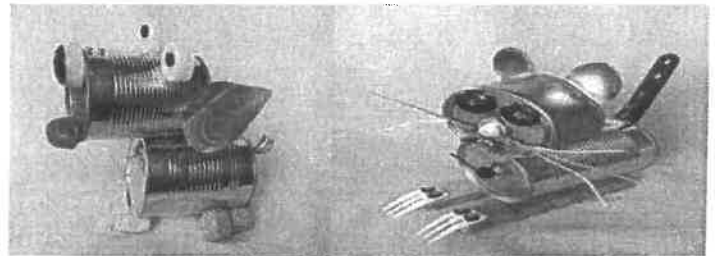
Anything's imaginable as long as it's made from recycled/re-used materials that would've normally gone into your recycle bin!
