## **Background Information:**

- Per Texas law grades Kindergarten through Grade 4 are required to have a 22:1 student/teacher ratio.
- We have a total of 16 waivers for this school year at this time. They are as follows: <u>Coder Elementary – 2 waivers</u> All in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 1 class at 23:1, 1 class at 24:1 (1 class at 22:1) <u>McCall Elementary – 3 waivers</u> All in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 3 classes at 23:1 (1 class at 22:1) <u>Stuard Elementary – 8 waivers</u> 4 in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 1 class at 23:1, 2 classes at 24:1, 1 class at 25:1 4 in 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 4 classes at 24:1 (1 class at 22:1) <u>Vandagriff Elementary – 3 waivers</u> 2 in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 2 classes at 23:1 (2 classes at 22:1) 1 in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 1 class at 23:1, (4 classes at 22:1)

### Administrative Considerations:

- In the 2012-2013 school year the district received a Class Size Waiver for three of our four elementary schools, Coder, Stuard, and Vandagriff, that involved a total of 6 waivers. Coder and Vandagriff each had 1 classroom that exceeded 22:1 and Stuard had 4 classrooms that exceeded 22:1.
- In 2011-2012 school year the district received a Class Size Waiver for all four elementary campuses for a total of 14 waivers that exceeded 22:1.
- 4 additional elementary teachers were added in 2012-2013, 5 additional elementary teachers have been added for the 2013-2014 school year.
- Minimize the impact of increased class size in the primary grades of Kinder, 1, and 2
