Background Information:

- The administration has identified the need to replace aging maintenance vehicles; currently there are 39 maintenance vehicles over 15 years old.
- The district currently has maintenance vehicles that are not operational due to unavailability of parts or repair costs exceed vehicle value.

Administrative Considerations:

- The vehicle lease agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management will replace aging vehicles, ensuring a modern fleet that enhances operational efficiency.
- This agreement facilitates cost predictability by locking in fixed yearly payments, allowing for better budgeting and financial planning.
- This agreement provides routine vehicle service and maintenance that will minimize downtime, maximize productivity, and reduce yearly repair costs.
- Projected budget by year: Year 1 = \$307,181 and Years 2 to 5 = \$198,981 per year
- Funds will be allocated from the Facility Support 2025-2026 operating budget.
