School/Building Improvement:

- From a day to day basis, we have not been interrupted with construction. Students are doing well with the temporary changes in place (moving building to building outside)
- Looking at ways to improve/support Student Social Emotional Learning in the coming weeks with Olga Lopez

Curriculum and Instruction

- Our Math department has been working on implementing our Math new curriculum
- Students have been enjoying the different electives that are fostering creative thinking, public speaking, and overall creativity.

Assessment

- Started providing Intervention Supports 2nd week of the school year (49 students in total - Prior to MAP testing from Spring 2023)
- Fall 2023 MAP testing went well as did our Panoramic Surveys
- Just started our 2nd wave of Intervention Supports after the latest MAP testing.
- Jr. High was randomly selected to administer National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) - February of 2024

Pretzel Positives

- 18 students from our 1st Intervention Support moved out of needing Interventions based off last MAP data (36.7%)
- Students have earned 1104 Pride Points so far this year (Polite, Responsible, Inclusive, Determined, Engaged)
- Panorama Datar
 - Social Emotional (compared to this time last year)
 - Self-Efficacy improved from 9% to 24% (% of student excelling)
 - Growth Mindset improved from 20% to 22% (% of student excelling)
 - Self-Management improved from 43% to 48% (% of student excelling)
 - Social Awareness improved from 16% to 25% (% of student excelling)
 - Emotional Regulation improved from 15% to 19% (% of student excelling)
 - All greats sign that SEL is moving in the right direction!!
