Have refined some items since December presentation – staffing commitment to remain the same of 1.0 FTE for elementary (any additional staffing needed will come out of elementary staffing allocation), additional 1.0 FTE at the middle school level (no staffing allowance was provided this year), \$5000 start-up costs for the second year for program expansion. District commitment of 3 additional years, through 2013-14 for program development and sustainability.

yet, will begin upon approval. Looking at the same number of students as in the grade 4-5 classroom. Have seen the positive impact on students/student learning.

B. All Day Every Day Kindergarten Program, Pam Miller, Kim Carlson

- Program provided at each elementary site effective 2011-12
- \$2487 fee with \$100 nonrefundable registration fee
- Sliding fee available for free/reduced lunch population
 - o Reduced at 75% of total fee
 - o Free at 50% of total fee
- Free half-day option still available
- Payments handled through Community Ed − 3 payment options
- Start-up costs estimated at \$31,000-\$73,000
- Communication will begin immediately
