# Strategic Blueprint Goal: Building Human Capital

Develop a robust professional development system that is relevant, timely, pertinent, and personalized for every staff member to enhance teaching and learning through collaboration.



# Center for Public Education Professional Development Study Findings (2013)

- PD must be **significant** and **ongoing** to allow **time** for teachers to learn a new strategy and grapple with the implementation.
- It is important to provide **support during implementation** that addresses the **specific challenges** of **changing classroom practice**.
- Initial exposure to a concept should engage teachers through varied approaches so they can participate actively in making sense of a new practice.
- Modeling/coaching has been found to be a highly effective way to introduce a new concept and help teachers understand a new practice.
- The PD content should be grounded in the teacher's **subject area** (for middle school and high school teachers) or **grade-level** (for elementary school teachers).






### West 40 Science Training

We are using Jim Knight's *The Impact Cycle* to inform one-on-one work with teachers who are interested in working collaboratively with a coach to enhance their practice and focus on a particular need in their classrooms.
