Purpose of Report:

The purpose of this report is to provide campus and district ADA percentages for the 2nd Reporting Period of the 2021-2022 school year (September 27, 2021 through November 5, 2021) and to compare this data to prior years. This report will also identify current truancy prevention measures being used on Denton ISD campuses to increase student attendance.

Objective:

The objective is to routinely analyze and monitor Denton ISD's attendance data with the goal of improving student attendance. By making this data readily accessible throughout the school year, the district will raise awareness of school attendance and monitor trends and changes across the district. The district will also provide transparent communication, training, and support; where needed, to improve student attendance in Denton ISD.

Operational Impact:

The analysis and monitoring of attendance data will increase the funding received from ADA, increase academic success and school completion, and support the district goal ensuring that all students are reading on grade level by the end of grade 3.

Results:

There are 28 instructional days in this 2nd Reporting Period. The district ADA % for 2020-2021 Reporting Period 2 is 93.72%, this is a decrease from last school year when the ADA % was 97.41%. Because school districts have reported to TEA that attendance rates have declined due to COVID-19, the agency is implementing an adjustment to operational minutes to address attendance issues caused by COVID-19 during the first reporting period.

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For the reminder of the school year, districts can request a waiver for low attendance to excuse instructional days from ADA and FSP funding calculations that have attendance at least 10 percentage points below last school year's overall ADA for the district due to inclement weather, health, or safety-related issues. Denton ISD will submit this waiver in June for all applicable instructional days.

EP Rayzor had the highest ADA percentage for elementary campuses in Denton ISD at 96.76%. Harpool had the highest ADA percentage for middle school campuses in Denton ISD at 95.51%. Guyer had the highest ADA percentage for high school campuses in Denton ISD at 93.51%.

Reporting Period 2 Comparisons

EE (Early Childhood Education) had the highest ADA % at 95.89%, followed by 5th grade with 95.43%. 12th grade had the lowest ADA % at 90.90%, followed by 11th grade with 91.73%.

The truancy prevention measures used in Reporting Period 2 include, but are not limited to; automated phone calls, flyers, student and parent communications, warning letters (4,274), online truancy class Referrals (4228), in-person truancy class referrals (889), counselor referrals (741), attendance contracts (1285), campus interventions (1520), home visits (76), truancy officer referrals (27), court referrals and court contempts (22). Denton ISD campuses have provided over **13,062** truancy prevention measures in this 2nd Reporting Period.
