Focus for 2015-2016

Academic Goals for the 2015-2016 School Year:

- 1. As measured by the 2015-2016 fall to spring MAP test, 100% of our continuously enrolled students will make at least one year's growth in the area of Math.
- 2. As measured by a Pre and Post writing assessment 100% of continuously enrolled students will increase their average of all 6 traits by one point as measure on the 6 traits of Writing rubric.
- 3. As measured by the 2015-2016 fall to spring MAP test, 100% of our continuously enrolled student will make at least on year's growth in the area of Reading.
- 4. As measured by Tyler Student Management System, Cross Middle School will have at least a 95% attendance rate.
