



Coppell SAT Sub-Tests






Through years of research, ACT has developed a set of benchmarks to determine college readiness for the following courses based on sub-tests of the ACT.



Percent of Students College Ready





ACT Math by Highest Math Class




SAT Mathematics


SAT Math by Highest Course Level



SAT Scores and AP Science Classes




SAT Scores by Gender




Intended College Majors
