Basic information:
We are currently holding the old staff laptops and old student Chromebooks, district iPad's along with miscellaneous Desktops in-house for disposal. We have had offers for a buyback of these devices.
Background or historical information:
Currently, we have approximately 410 Dell and HP laptops, 2000+ iPads, 750 Chromebooks, and 70 Desktop computers that were returned by staff and students in the fleet that were refreshed for the school year 25-26. These devices, while no longer useful to us and have seriously depreciated in value, do still have a usable life outside of District 33. Instead of giving them to a vendor to melt down, we are asking for a buyback. We have been quoted (\$60,000 approx.) for the misc. Laptops and Desktops and (\$112,000 to 173,000 approx.) for iPads, with certification of data destruction.
