Fall 2025 MAP Scores

The attached chart summarizes the Fall 2025 Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment data for students in grades 1-8. The report details the mean RIT by grade level and subject, compares scores to national norms, and highlights the percentage of students achieving in the 80th percentile.

- **Academic Excellence:** Each grade level's mean RIT continues to trend significantly above the national norm across all subjects.
- **Consistency:** The mean RIT for both Mathematics and Reading remained consistent across all grade levels year-over-year.
- **High Achievement in Math:** All eight cohorts maintained or increased the number of students performing at or above the national 80th percentile.
- **High Achievement in Reading:** Six of the eight cohorts maintained or increased the number of students performing at or above the national 80th percentile. The decrease was minor for the third and sixth-grade cohorts, at 4% and 1%, respectively.

Summary

Overall, the data presented on the chart is overwhelmingly positive. Students are demonstrating expected growth in the majority of subjects and grade levels, consistently meeting or exceeding proficiency goals. Furthermore, mean RIT scores are stable and continue to significantly exceed national norms.
