Description: The Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments, are nationally recognized and used to measure student achievement and growth in math, reading, and science across grades K–12. The assessment provides educators with reliable, real-time data to inform instructional decisions and support students at all performance levels.

Historical Data: NWEA - MAP Growth has been used for 3 years to norm-reference students and monitor growth at the year's beginning, middle, and end. MAP data will support "student growth measures" for the Teachers' Incentive Allotment or TIA.

Recommendation: Approve the purchase of NWEA - MAP for the 2025-2026 school year.


WHAT IS MAP?



Computer-adaptive tests designed to measure student achievement and growth in math, reading, and science. These assessments are administered multiple times a year to students in grades K-12. MAP assessments help educators understand where students are on their learning path, track their progress over time, and inform instructional strategies.

How a student <u>performs</u> in a tested subject relative to grade level peers.

Achievement is Normed

Same grade
Same test
Same instructional weeks
Compared to all students
50 = typical achievement (not grade level)
65 = Meets
80-85 = Masters




Growth Percentile

How a student <u>progresses</u> in the tested subject relative to students with similar past performance.

Growth is Normed

Same grade
Same test
Same instructional weeks
Same starting score
50 = typical growth
60 = accelerated growth


