## ALIGNS TO BOARD PRIORITY:

 Learning – Learning – The District will provide an aligned, rigorous curriculum, with instructional and technology programs preparing students to meet or exceed all educational standards.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The adoption of Proclamation 2017 instructional materials along with resources in our current inventory will allow the district to provide resources to our staff to cover 100% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) during the 2017- 2018 school year. The TEKS Certification form is being presented for approval to facilitate the procurement of instructional materials for the next school year. Below is a list of the criteria to be met for authorizing the TEKS IMA Certification form:

The district superintendent along with the president and secretary of the local board of trustees, must certify the following:

- That the district's instructional materials allotment (IMA) is used only for expenses allowable by the Texas Education Code (TEC), 31.0211.
- That for the current school year, this district has instructional materials that collectively cover all elements of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills of the required curriculum identified in the TEC, 28.002, other than physical education, for each subject and grade level (TEC 31.1004).
- That, upon request, the district will provide to the State Board of Education the title and publication information for any instructional materials requisitioned or purchased by the district with the district's IMA (TEC 31.101).

**ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:** Consider approval of the Instructional Materials Allotment and TEKS Certification form.

**FISCAL NOTE:** Instructional materials will be purchased by using the instructional materials funds provided by the state to the school district.
