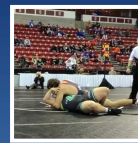
Snowball 2022: More than Frozen Fun!

On Tuesday, March 1st, Unity High School hosted a mock-ACT event for all of the junior students. This session focused on preparing the juniors for the ACT test, which will take place on Tuesday, March 8th.
