What is the Midcycle Report?

- 30-page document, emphasis on Standard 1
 - Additional 15 pages on outstanding recommendations
- Articulate CCC's goals for a less formal check-in
 - Progress towards goals
 - Invite input on future work
- Demonstrate progress on CCC's recommendations



Standard 1

- Covers:
 - Institutional Mission (1.A)
 - Improving Institutional Effectiveness (1.B.1-4)
 - Student Learning (1.C.1-9)
 - Student Achievement (1.D.1-4)

*Note: Standard 2 is covered in the Year 6 Review

Mid-Cycle Report Components

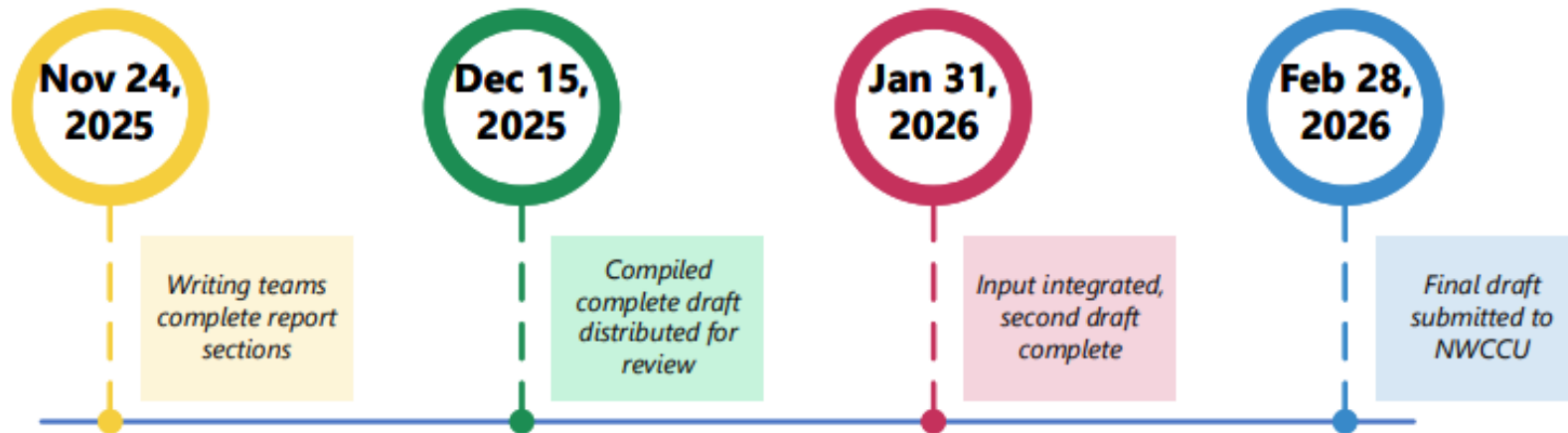
- 4 sections:
 - Mission Fulfillment (Standard 1.B.2, 1.B.4)
 - Student Achievement (Standard 1.B.4, 1.D.2, 1.D.3, 1.D.4)
 - Assessment (Standard 1.C.5, 1.C.6, 1.C.7)
 - Moving Forward
- Addenda
 - Address outstanding recommendations

Outstanding Recommendations

Recommendation 1: Fall 2024 Ad Hoc Report with Visit - Regularly and systematically evaluate associate faculty. (2020 Standard(s) 2.F.4)

Recommendation 2: Spring 2023 Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness - More fully and consistently use the results of its assessment efforts to inform academic and learning-support planning and practices to continuously improve student learning outcomes. (2020 Standard(s) 1.C.7)
