Re: TEA Class Size Waiver

As required by the Texas Education Code §25.112, we are required to submit a class size waiver request to the Texas Education Agency for any class sections in grades K-4 that exceed the state allowable class size limit of 22:1. Additionally, we are required to submit a compliant plan as to the action(s) that will be taken to bring the district back into compliance with the class size limitation.

Due to unanticipated student growth, and too few 3rd grade teachers to accommodate the growth, two sections in Grade 3 at Wilson Elementary have exceeded the 22:1 ratio by one student in each of the two sections. That is, two sections will have a 23:1 ratio instead of the state mandated maximum of 22:1. In order to send these two students to other campuses would not only require a new and separate bus route to transport the students, but would also, in one case, split siblings requiring them to attend two different campuses. Both of these students live directly across the street from Wilson Elementary. The principal of Wilson Elementary, Katy Cooper, requested this waiver in the educational best interest of these two students.

After the waiver request is approved by TEA, TEC §25.113 requires that we provide written notice of the granted exception to the parent of each student affected by the exception. This would only include and relate to the 23 students in the two 3rd grade sections affected at Wilson Elementary.

Attached to this memo are the required waiver request and the compliance plan. Both documents require Board of Trustee approval, as well as Superintendent and Board President signatures.

Recommendation: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the Texas Education

the Compliance Plan as required by the Texas Education Code

Enter the total number of sections and the reason(s) for the waiver request. Class size limits do not apply to physical education or fine arts classes.
